Self-taught, she perfected the technique to make vintage jewelry. She made earrings for her barbie dolls and learned to reproduce pearl earrings and necklaces to complete the look on her head vases.

Chrestina shares with us a few of the ladies she has in her extensive head vase collection.

She became a head vase collector shortly after visiting her grandmother in the hospital. One of her grandmother's friends gave her a head vase as a gift to help cheer her up.

Chrestina couldn't help but admire the lovely and delicate lady head vase.

It was shortly after visiting her grandmother that she came across her first head vase while shopping for treasures.

With fond memories of the head vase her grandmother received while she was in the hospital, Chrestina purchased her and of course, that was the beginning of her collection.

Over the years, Chrestina continued to seek more lady head vases to add to her collection.

A lot of the heads she purchased were missing their jewelry and this prompted her to learn how to make replacement earrings and necklaces on her own.





Chrestina also enjoys collecting an assortment of vintage dolls.

Around the same time she found her first head vase, she came across a Barbie bubblecut doll.

Having owned the same doll when she was a little girl, she bought her and before she knew it, she was hooked and started her Barbie collection.

Her collections soon took off and she continues to add to her head vase, Barbie doll and vintage doll collections.

For over twelve years Chrestina has been making replacement jewelry for her growing collections.

Chrestia uses Cultura glass pearls when creating her earrings and necklaces.

She finds that Cultura glass pearls replicate the luster, weight and feel of genuine pearls and even surpass them in their flawless surfaces.

There are some dolls in her collection where she uses gold tone earrings for a newer look and she also created earrings with a tarnished look to fit the era.

Small – 3mm pearls strung 4” long
Large – 4mm pearls strung 6” long
